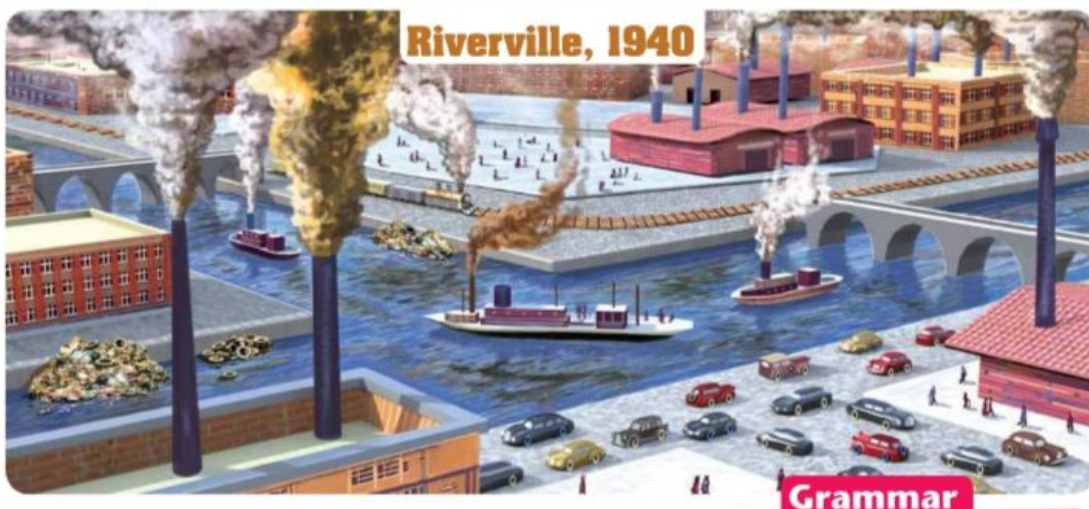
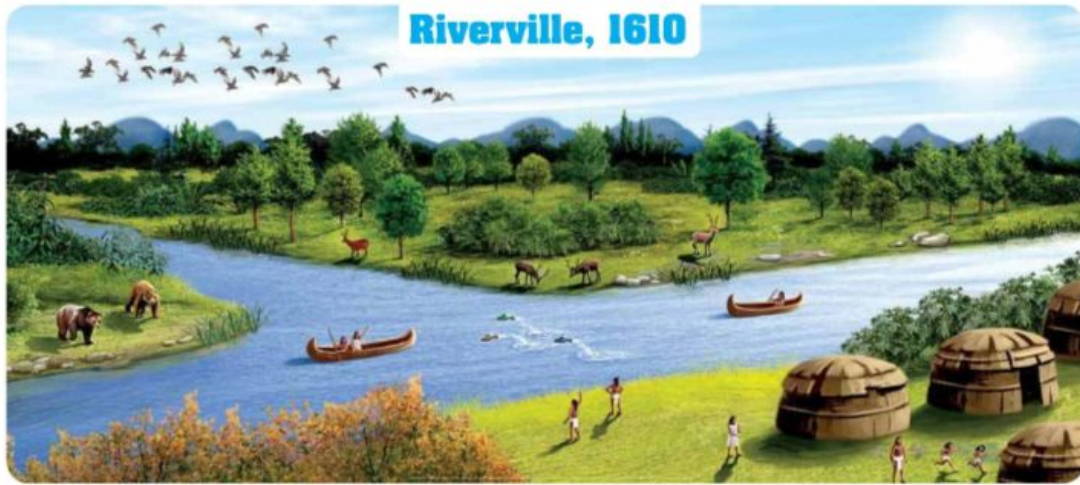
Look at the two pictures of Riverville in the past (in 1610 and in 1940).
