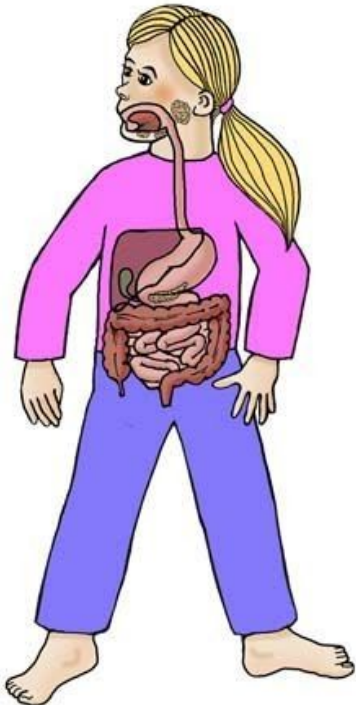










# The digestive system

## Parts and functions

Match the part with the name and its function.



	tongue	A fluid that contains enzymes and helps break down food in your mouth.
	esophagus	Absorbs any left over water and salt.
	large intestine	Moves the food around in the mouth to help break it down and mix it with saliva.
	liver	Long tube that squeezes food down into the stomach.
	pancreas	Digestion finishes here and all nutrients are absorbed into blood
	salivary glands	Mixes the food with gastric juices.
	small intestine	Makes digestive juices with enzymes and delivers it to the small intestine.
	stomach	Makes a fluid called bile that helps digest fats.
