## A New Haiku for You

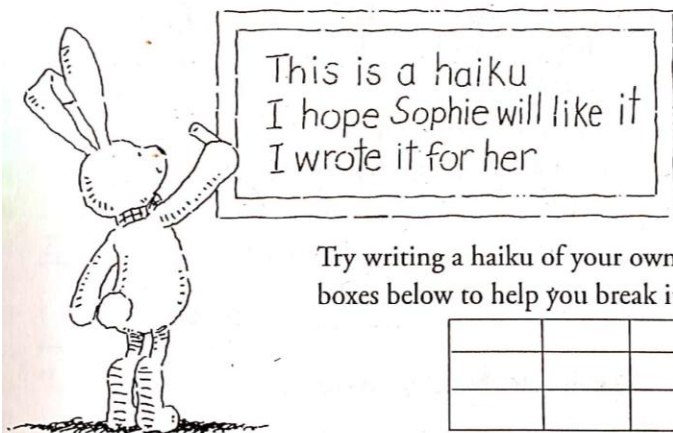
A haiku is a type of Japanese poem. It has 3 lines and 17 syllables.

The first line of a haiku has 5 syllables, the second has 7 syllables, and the last has 5 syllables again. What is a syllable?

Felix was inspired to write a haiku by his amazing trip to feudal Japan. This is what Felix's haiku looks like with every syllable in its own box. You can see that most of the words that Felix uses are one syllable.
