long caterpillars,

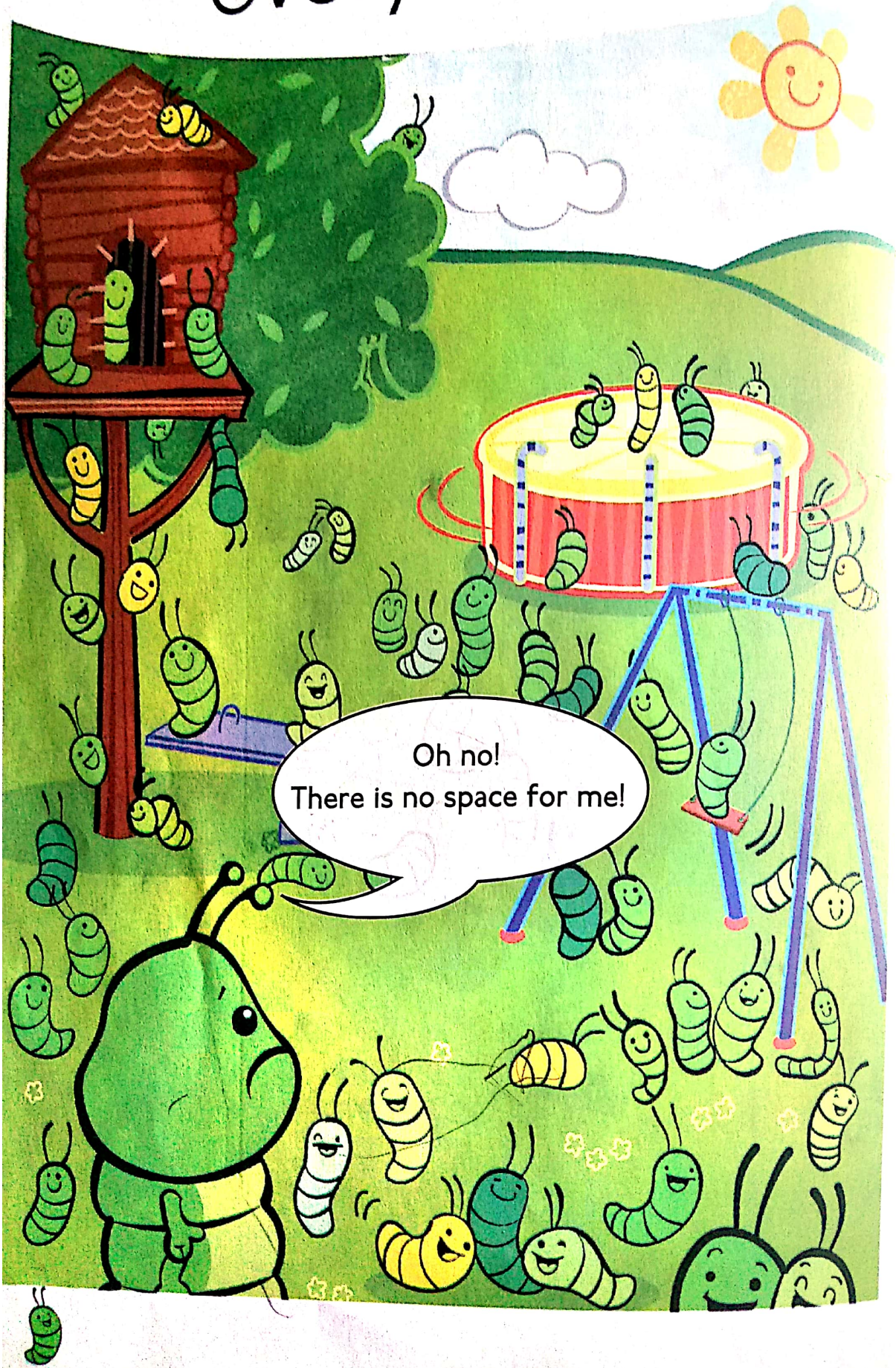
There are caterpillars everywhere!

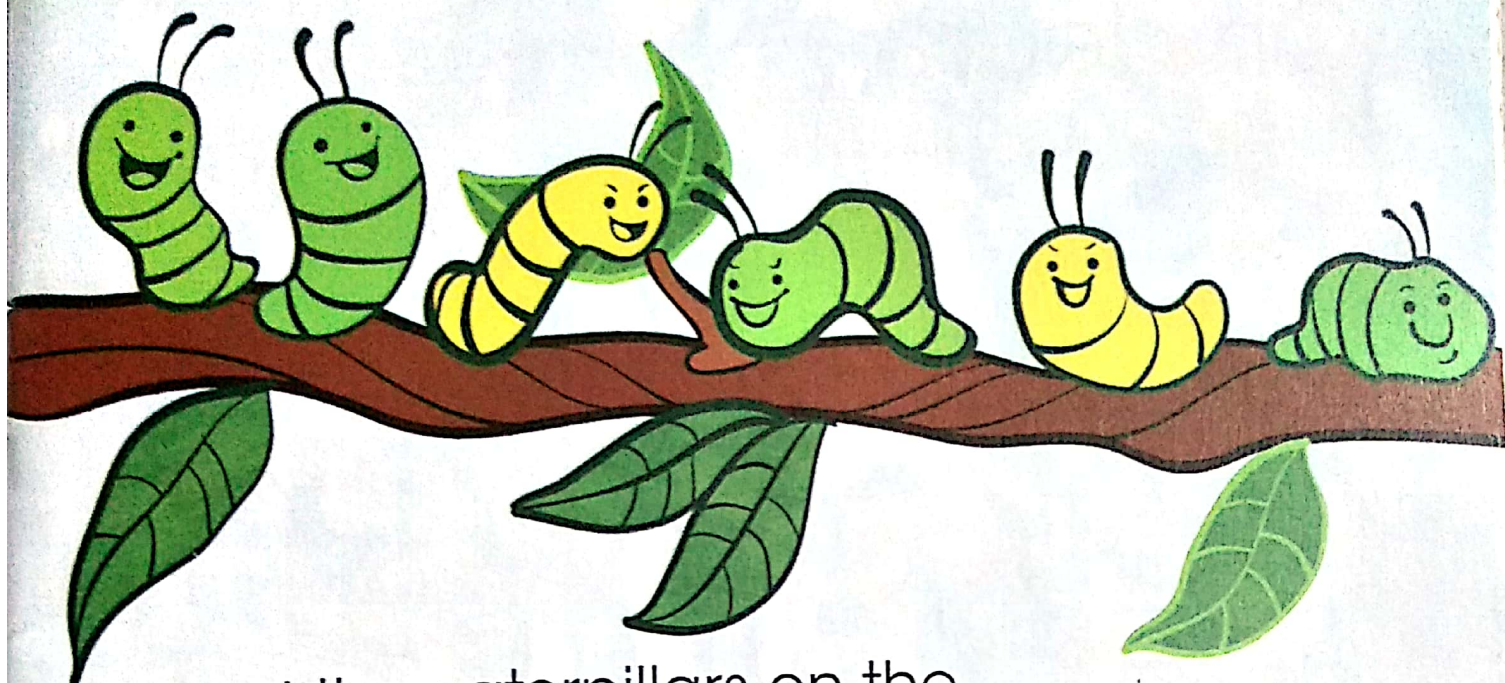


short caterpillars, fat caterpillars
and thin caterpillars.



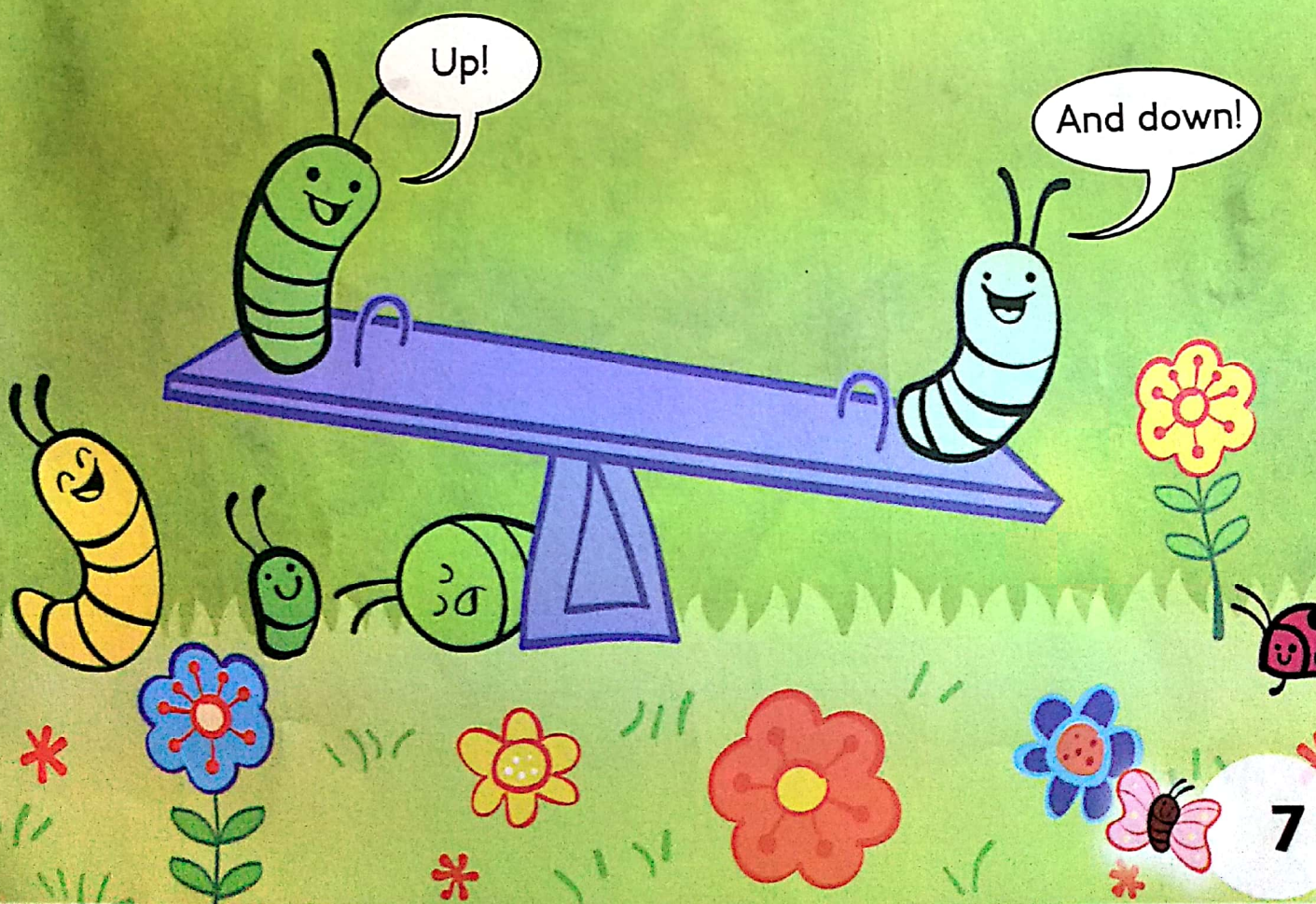
Callum is in the park. Look at the caterpillars!

everywhere!



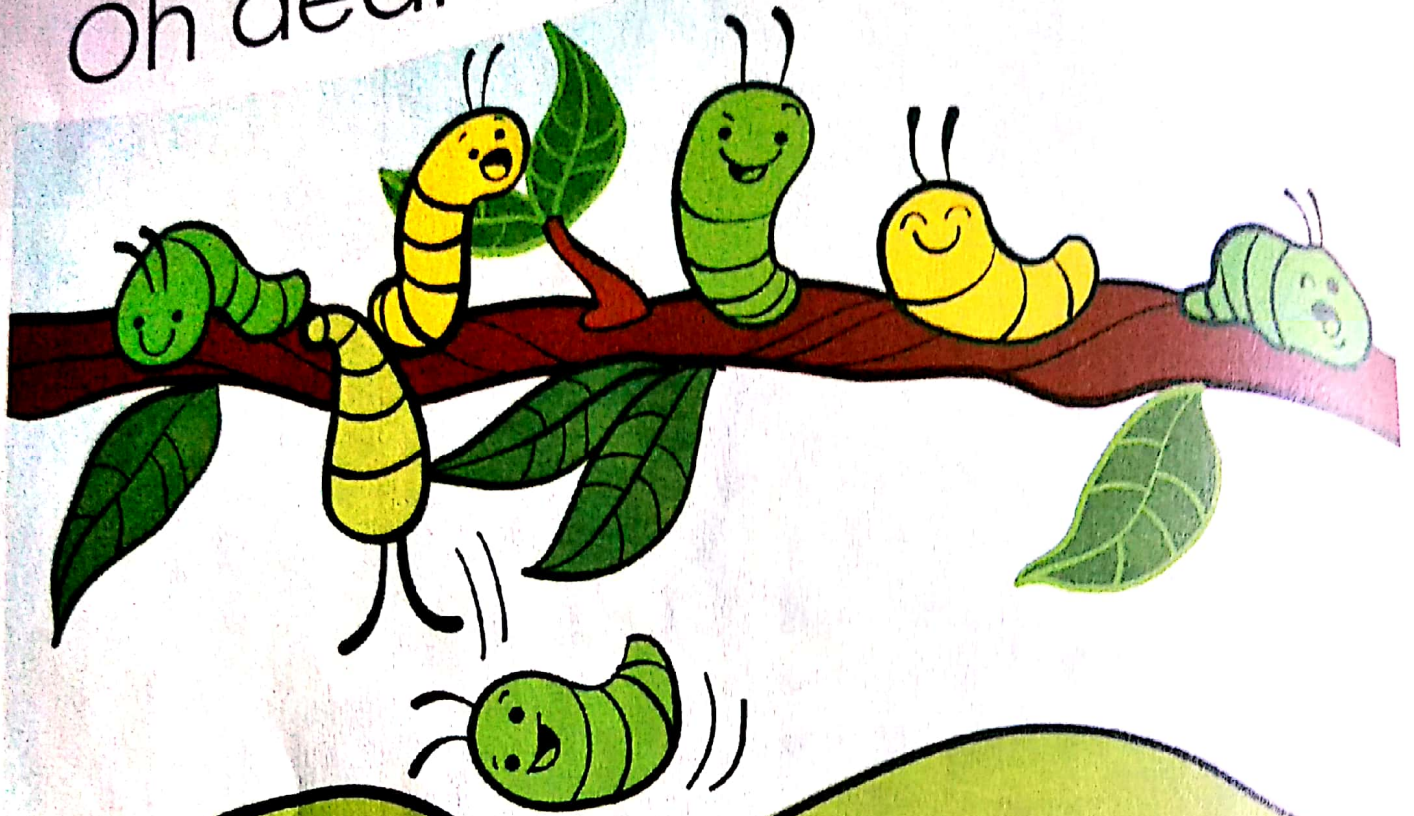


Look at the caterpillars on the tree!
